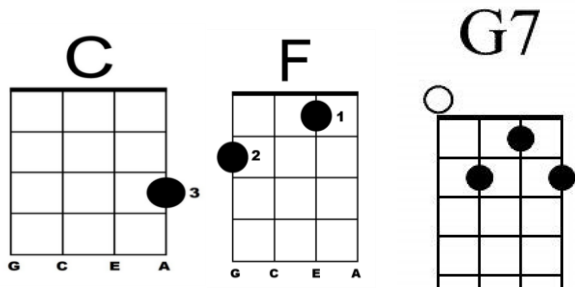

For beginning ukulele players – conquer and divide. Make 3 groups, assign each group a specific chord. Strum strings only on assigned chord, air strum all other measures.

Create a lyrical style dance with streamers, scarves, or other props.

Create a sound carpet with unpitched instruments – example: wind chimes, bells, etc. Sound carpet may be used as intro, interlude and/or coda.

This piece could be used for a 5th grade graduation. Ask each 5th grade teacher, specialist, and administrator to write/read a ‘wish’ for the graduating class. After the song is sung, 2-4 teachers read/speak their wish to the class. Form: ABABABA...
